REPORTS

Secretary's Report: May minutes accepted.

Treasurer's Report: (Marie Q) Reviewed and accepted.

Answering Service: (Deborah) All is well. Groups are sending their lists and there were no gaps in coverage this month. In May we received 13 phone calls. Discussion of when, if ever, the phone service employees should provide information to callers who are "just looking for a meeting" or if all calls should be directed to AA members. Phone service reps will be given the phone number to reach the SENY Spanish Liaison (Fatima) if they need someone to return calls from Spanish-speaking callers.

Bridging the Gap: (Roy) NY Intergroup Bridging the Gap had seven requests last month, and six of them were answered.

Bookers: Joe covered tonight's RC Bookers Exchange. There was a good turnout. There was also the familiar complaint that most groups had already booked before the official start time. Please announce at home groups that Intergroup needs someone to take the booker commitment, which is only one meeting per quarter, and remind the new Bookers Chair to begin the meetings on time.

Women's Corrections — (Debbie) Absent. No report.

Hospitals and Institutions: (Kristin) Raised concerns that some speakers who take H&I commitments are not sharing A.A.'s message, especially about working the 12 Steps. In response it was decided that we will share the pamphlet *A.A. in Treatment Settings* with meeting chairs and group members taking these commitments.
